



Multiple Desktop Folders

Create a RinkWriter folder on your desktop and treat it as your master folder.

Open the folder and run RinkWriter from inside of the folder. Set it up as your master folder by entering as much information as possible:

- Names of all of the teams you may encounter...?
- Enter all of the team rosters that you can find...?
- Enter the names of coaches (for each team)...?
- Name of your Arena.
- Name of Conference(s).

Copy your master folder and paste enough copies on your desktop so you have one for each level of play that may be encountered. Rename the new folders for each circumstance.



At this point, each team and/or scorekeeper can be responsible for their folder. They can enter the names of the teams they will be playing, the team rosters, names of coaches, and any other desired information. Each team folder will have its own "app.pathRW02" folder and therefore, each team folder will have its own data base.

As games are completed, team rosters, names of coaches, names of available officials, etc., will be updated within each team folder.

Many teams may use the same computer desktop. Folders could be copied to a flash drive and be taken home by scorekeepers. Scorekeepers could set up their folders before arriving at the arena...and paste them back on to the desktop.

This flexibility offers many options. See information for setting up a tournament with multiple folders....one for each game.
