

The Time Calculator

Whenever a Penalty or Goal occurs, the scorekeeper should open the "Penalty" or "Goal" form and record the Arena Scoreboard time in the Time Calculator.

If the Scoreboard Clock shows "6:17", the scorekeeper should record that on the "Time Calculator".

Next, click on the "Calculate the Expired Time" button.

The "Time Calculator" automatically appears when the scorekeeper opens the "Goal" or "Penalty" forms.

The scorekeeper's first priority should be to determine and enter the scoreboard time.

First, the scorekeeper should enter the expired time... and by then...

The referee will be reporting the scoring or penalty to the scoring table, and then, the scorekeeper can finish entering the goal or penalty.



If the scorekeeper fails to enter the correct expired time, an error message will appear in the Game Log...and the scorekeeper will be instructed to correct the expired time.
